Upper Tier (Advanced Juniors) ...aka "The Championship-Tees" Program

- Comprehensive one week program (**5 days/Mon-Fri**) specifically tailored to advanced, aspiring junior golfers (ages between 9-18) looking to elevate their game to the next level.
- Offered: **June 8-12, June 15-19, June 22-26, June 29-July 3, July 6-10, July 13-17, July 20-24, July 27-31, Aug 3-7, Aug 10-14**; Everyday runs from **8:30am-12:30pm (lunch following)**; certain days will extend to **3pm** due to afternoon play (optional).

Details of Junior Membership include:

- **Membership card** with photo identification (required at all times)
- **Membership bag tag** with name
- Unlimited **playing** and/or **practicing privileges**.
- **Accessibility to (5) championship golf courses** granted upon availability. Casual play (non-instructional) arrangements must be made via the pro shop.
- The **ability to bring guests** between the ages of 8-15 for a fee of \$20 plus tax (players must walk). Those guests/adults older than 16 (valid drivers license) must take a cart and will be charged \$23 plus tax over and above the guest fee.
- **Invitation to ALL summer camp tournaments**, including *Junior Club Championship*. Parent/ Junior Tournaments will wave green fees, however, will charge \$11.50 plus tax cart fee for each participant.

- I will be understanding and respectful of dangerous weather situations and will follow the directions of staff for my safety.
- I will not "hang out" in the Golf Shop
