- *First Book:* **THE HELP** by Kathryn Stockett: Mississippi 1962 – white ladies playing bridge and sipping iced tea; colored maids cooking, cleaning, loving the white babies. Their intertwined worlds are about to collide. (hard-cover)
- *Second Book:* **INDIGNATION** (paperback, Fall 2009) by Philip Roth: a young man from Newark, obsessively worried about being drafted into the Korean War, ends up at a conservative college in Ohio to escape his overbearing father.
- *Third Book:* **IMPORTANT ARTIFACTS AND PERSONAL PROPERTY FROM THE COLLECTION OF LENORE DOOLAN AND HAROLD MORRIS** by Leanne Shapton: **WARNING:** This is the strangest “novel” you’ll ever read! [paper catalogue]
