PGA NATIONAL JUNIOR CODE OF CONDUCT

I, _____, understand that it is a privilege to attend the Summer Junior Program offered by PGA National and I appreciate all that my parents have done to make it possible for me to participate.

I promise to behave in a manner that will make my family proud by:

- 1) Being properly dressed at all times. When at PGA National I will wear golf shirts and shorts/pants. My shirt will be tucked in and if I wear a hat, the brim will be forward at all times when worn. Hats will be removed when I enter a building.
- 2) I will be respectful and use good manners every time I speak to another student, an instructor, or any member of staff.
- 3) I will listen to instructions carefully and follow them at ALL times.
- 4) I will follow all club rules which include but are not limited to:
 - Signing in daily for my instruction session
 - Signing in at the Golf Shop each time I access the facility for casual play.
 - Carry my membership card with me at all times.
 - Respect the facility by taking care of the courses and surrounding areas. Pick up trash, repair ball marks and divots. I understand that damaging any property at PGA National, golf course or otherwise, may result in my summer membership being revoked.
 - Staying out of and away from all golf carts unless you have a valid drivers' license and you have registered and paid in the Golf Shop to use, or you are being shuttled by staff to or from a location. Unauthorized use of any golf cart at any time will result in my summer membership being revoked.
 - I will be understanding and respectful of dangerous weather situations and will follow the directions of staff for my safety.
 - I will NOT "hang out" in the Golf Shop
- 5) I will play by the rules of golf and use honesty and integrity in all that I do.
