Dear Members,

In just a matter of days, we will play host to the 2010 Honda Classic, so there is no better time than now to focus on the upcoming days and weeks as we prepare for and orchestrate the event. Hunker in; there is a great deal of information to share:

- The 2010 Honda Classic will be played March 4 - 7, 2010 with practice rounds beginning on Friday, February 26, 2010, after noon.
- The Tournament Construction has begun. Equipment staging is located in the Spa parking lot near #1 tee of the Haig. As we get closer to the start of the event, parking will become more and more at a premium so we ask that you consider car pooling.
- Restricted parking will begin on Monday, March 1, 2010. Any member with a starting time on property Monday, March 1 – Sunday, March 7, will need to have a valet pass that will be issued at the Will Call Office located at the Fire Station at Mirasol. **One parking pass will be issued per foursome** and can be picked up one day prior to the day of play. Will Call will be staffed Sunday, February 28 – Sunday, March 7, from 7:00 am until 5:00 pm.
- The Men's Lockers must be cleaned out by noon on Saturday, February 27.
- The Ladies Locker Room will not be accessible after Sunday, February 28, so although the Ladies do not have to clean out their lockers, we ask that you take all necessary items home prior to the 28th.
- We will begin our remote staging of carts and clubs on February 18th. Carts for the Haig and Palmer will be staged by #9 tee of the Haig, and carts for the Squire will be staged by #18 green of the Squire. Experience has shown that the main staging area becomes too congested prior to the event so in an effort to improve your golf experience, we are starting remote staging earlier than years past.
- Accurate information on the tee sheets is vitally important. We are asking for your assistance in providing complete and accurate information on the tee sheet so we can effectively and efficiently transport players and equipment where they need to go. Lack of correct information will delay your day and result in frustration felt by many.
- Beginning Monday, March 1, members and their guests may register for golf on their respective starting tee. Only those paying cash will be asked to register in the Golf Shop.
- Since access will be restricted, we ask that any member playing the Estate Monday, March 1 – Sunday, March 7, remove your clubs from storage and keep them with you. Retrieving your clubs from storage during the restricted parking period can be quite cumbersome.
- A \$100 fee will be charged to any member who picks up a parking pass and subsequently does not play golf on the assigned day. To avoid the penalty, passes must be returned to Will Call no later than 9:00 am on the day of play.
- Members caught taking their carts out of bounds to deliver players or clubs home or those who take golf carts home will be suspended and face criminal charges. I hate to have to address this issue; however, we have wasted a great deal of time policing members who felt it was their right to behave in this manner. For the safety and protection of all, please do not take carts out of bounds. This applies year round; however, it is extremely important during this busy time.
- The Haig Range will be available for warm up March 1 – March 7. The Champion Range will close and be for the Tour Players Only beginning at noon on Friday, February 26. If you are playing the Squire, we will shuttle you from the Squire remote staging to the Haig Range and back.
- If you wish only to practice, we ask that you utilize the practice facility at the Estate Course.

It is an honor to host a PGA Tour event, and a huge undertaking to keep all of our golf courses in full operation during the event. We have had great success in the past with our valet pass, remote staging, and shuttle systems. We appreciate your support and your patience and we look forward to another very successful event.
